Announcement of the 7th International Colloquium on Bioethics, Neuroethics and AI Ethics

Pontifical Catholic University of Rio Grande do Sul (PUCRS)

Submission:

1. The submission of papers extended until **May 10, 2023**, through the form available at [this link](#), following, **mandatorily**, all the instructions contained in this announcement.
2. The Scientific Committee will select the submitted papers based on the following criteria:
 - thematic pertinence to the research area in (I) Bioethics, (II) Neuroethics and/or (III) AI Ethics;
 - academic quality of the work, considering the graduate level and research of the proponent;
 - strict observance of the announced deadlines.
3. Abstracts may be submitted by students regularly enrolled in *stricto sensu* Graduate Programs (Master's, Doctoral students), or in a Post-Doctoral internship, and professors developing research on (I) Bioethics, (II) Neuroethics and/or (III) AI Ethics. PhD and Master's degree holders can also submit abstracts.
4. Submission of only one paper per author will be accepted.
5. Co-authored papers will be accepted.

6. The author of the paper should make the presentation. If there is any impediment, the author should contact us by e-mail neuroethics2020@gmail.com in advance to justify his/her absence and, if necessary, eventual substitution by his/her co-author.

7. In case of publication in a dossier, annals or book, the names of the author and co-authors will be included.

8. The abstract **must** contain

- between 300 and 500 words;
- title;
- up to three keywords;
- .pdf format.

9. The body of the text should be

- typed in Times New Roman font;
- size 12;
- 1.5 line spacing;
- justified alignment.

10. Both the submitted abstract can be written and the paper can be presented in the following languages:

- Portuguese;
- Spanish;

- English.

11. If the abstract does not comply with the above requirements, it will be disqualified by the Scientific Committee.

Assessment and acceptance:

1. Abstracts that meet the above requirements will be evaluated within the blind peer review system by the Scientific Committee according to the following criteria:

- relevance to the chosen area;
- mastery, pertinence and updating of the bibliography
- theoretical and methodological adequacy;
- dissertative rigor, conciseness, and argumentative capacity.

2. Acceptance/rejection letters for abstracts submitted for communication will be sent **until May 10, 2023** to the e-mail address provided by the proposer in the abstract submission form.

Communication:

1. The 7th International Colloquium on Bioethics, Neuroethics and AI Ethics will be held both face-to-face and virtual, and papers only virtual via Zoom.

2. Each communicator will have up to 15 (fifteen) minutes to present his/her work and up to 10 (ten) minutes for debate.

3. The Zoom link will be sent via e-mail to those approved, as well as the time and date of the presentation.

Certification:

1. The delivery of the work presentation certificate will be conditioned to the effective presentation of the paper and with the due registration at the event - <https://webapp.pucrs.br/inscricao-siproex/?projeto=ab162aded8be9e9e>

2. A certificate of participation will be awarded to those who complete at least 70% of the workload of the event in person and online.

Publication:

1. At the end of the event, the Scientific Committee will contact by e-mail those who submitted abstracts within the theme of the event and presented the communication to verify their interest in publishing the e-book, open access by the Fenix Foundation Publishing House (www.fundarfenix.com.br).

2. The approval of the abstract and the presentation do not automatically guarantee future publication. The Scientific Committee will be in charge of the selection of the works after the end of the event, with a date still to be defined and communicated by e-mail to the communicators.
